For general and obedience classes, members must be at club at least 15minutes earlier than class start time. Classes will start with activities straight up, so it is your responsibility to sign in, pay your \$2 weekly training fee (excluding foundation) and walk/settle your dog before class start.

For agility and flyball, helping out in either pack up or set up is a requirement to be able to participate in these classes.

Foundation:

A 6 week course that all new members are required to participate in. Teaches basic dog social skills and gives members a taste of all dog activities including flyball, agility, obedience and doggy dancing.

Flyball:

Advanced – for all “team” members

Starters –for anyone from beginners to intermediate, will be one on one

Agility:

Advanced – for all “trailing” members

Starters – for anyone from beginners to intermediate, will be tailored to your level

Obedience:

Intermediate – 2 classes including Intermediate Puppy and Intermediate Adults

Advanced – 3 classes including Pink, Yellow and Trialling

We do not have an official line up procedure for the start of Starters Flyball and Starters Agility like we do for Obedience, as it tends to be more of a one on one with the instructor. Please make sure you let the instructor know that you are wanting training as it can be quite difficult for instructors to tell whether you are just watching or actually want to join in. Please don't be shy!
