ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND COMMITTEE:

Nomination of candidates for election as Officers of the Club or as Ordinary Members of Committee:

A. Shall be made in writing, signed by one member of the Club and accompanied by the written consent of the candidate. (Written consent is signified by the candidate's signature in the space provided on the nomination form) and'

B. Shall be delivered to the Secretary of the Club not less than 21 days prior to the date fixed for the holding of the Annual General Meeting.

NOTICES OF MOTION:

C. Any notice of a motion to be placed on the Agenda for discussion at the Annual General Meeting shall be delivered to the Club Secretary not less than 21 days before the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting.

ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE:

D. A member is not entitled to vote at any General Meeting unless all monies due and payable by him/her to the Club in respect of the current financial year have been paid.

E. Members are required to have been financial for a minimum period of three (3) months prior to the end of the financial year ending 30th June 2010 in order to be entitled to vote.

POSTAL VOTES:

F. Members eligible to vote may apply for a postal vote. Applications for a postal vote must be lodged with the Secretary 14 days prior to the Annual General Meeting. Completed ballot papers must be returned in an envelope marked "BALLOT PAPERS".
